The Beauregard Family has been farming premium wine grapes in Bonny Doon, California since 1949. Four generations later, the estate vines now span 63 acres of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Zinfandel.

The Beauregard mission is simple: to sustainably produce wines expressing terroir of the Santa Cruz Mountains through minimal impact winemaking. At Beauregard, wine is made in the vineyard. Fermentation takes place with native yeasts. Old world techniques are used in the cellar. Wines are aged on the lees in barrels for extended periods of time to develop character and show the unique coastal mountain terroir.

**Regan Vineyard**, is located in the Corrolitos area of the Santa Cruz Mountains on a south facing slope. The vineyard is owned and farmed by John Bargetto. Planted in 1992, the 50 acre estate sits at an elevation of 450 to 550 feet. Monterey Bay influences combine with clay loam soils to produce wines with minerality and striking acidity. Plantings: 2.5 acres Pinot Gris on 3309 rootstock.

Harvested on August 27. Brix at Harvest 20.
